Job Description

Burnaby MoreSports Society (BMS) is a non-profit organization that offers free after-school sports programs to elementary school children in underprivileged communities. BMS is seeking motivated Sports Program Leaders who can thrive in a fast-paced, high-energy work environment, working with senior staff to deliver high quality sports programs for children and youth in Burnaby.

The Program Leader is responsible for supervising children (ages 6-12), implementing sports lesson plans, supporting youth volunteers and leadership students, liaising with school staff/parents, and providing a safe, supportive environment for all participants. The Program Leader has to be flexible while working within established structures and routines to consistently meet program objectives.

Qualifications & Requirements

The ideal candidate would meet all of these criteria:

- Experience planning and leading activities for groups of children in a recreational sports setting
- Basic practical knowledge of core program sports: basketball, floor hockey, soccer
- Great teamwork ethic and adaptive management skills
- Criminal record check in place for working with children
- Certified in emergency first aid with CPR
- Working knowledge of child development, physical literacy, behaviour management, health and safety, guidance and counselling
- Demonstrable experience working with at-risk young people
- Excellent interpersonal, organizational and communication skills
- Strong group management skills, exercised with patience and respect
- Applied knowledge of social and emotional learning practices
- Cultural and social sensitivity that embraces diversity and multiculturalism
- Certified in High Five Principles of Healthy Child Development (PHCD)
- English as a first language with second language capabilities

Terms & Conditions

This is a part-time position working weekday shifts from 2:30-5:30pm for 3-9 hours per week based on availability and need. The hourly wage starts at \$16.08 per hour + 4% vacation pay. The position will run from October to December initially, and may be extended into 2019.
