Job Description

Burnaby MoreSports Society (BMS) is a registered charity providing sports and physical literacy for local children and youth. We work with community partners to eliminate traditional barriers to participation, so that more youngsters can enjoy sports in a safe, structured and non-competitive environment.

This summer, BMS is offering afternoon sports camps for children at Gilmore Community School! For this project, BMS is seeking two motivated Camp Leaders who can thrive in a fast-paced, high-energy work environment, working under the direction of the Camp Coordinator to deliver high-quality sports and recreation programs for all camp participants. Camp Leaders will be responsible for supervising children (ages 6-8), implementing sports and other recreational activity lesson plans, mentoring youth volunteers, and creating a safe, supportive environment for everyone. Camp Leaders will be flexible, while working within established structures and routines to consistently meet program objectives.

Qualifications & Requirements

The ideal candidate for this position would meet all of these criteria:

- Experience planning and leading recreational activities (i.e., sports, arts, crafts) for groups of children

- Criminal record check in place for working with vulnerable children (or willing to consent)
- Certified in HIGH FIVE Principles of Healthy Child Development (PHCD)
- Fluent in English, with second language capabilities an asset
- Eligibility requirements under the Canada Summer Jobs Program (i.e., under 30 years old, valid SIN, and legally entitled to reside and work in Canada as a citizen, landed immigrant or refugee)
